The Institute of Smart Structures and Systems (ISSS), is happy to announce the second Researchers' Forum for Post Graduate Students and Researchers on Micro and Smart Systems. This event will be held in association with the Department of Electrical Communication Engineering (ECE) at the Indian Institute of Science on 26-27 April 2019.

As in the first event held last year, this event is intended to provide an excellent platform for researchers across the country to come together and interact with each other. It is also planned to invite potential recruiters to this event to connect with them for exploiting upcoming opportunities.

Format of the Event

The event will have inspiring talks by leaders of select Startups on innovation landscape in this area, Prominent Academicians on opportunities in Academic Institutions, Industry leaders on opportunities available in Industries and Research Laboratories.

A highlight of this event will be a 3MT and a poster presentation by participating researchers in five streams, namely Physics of Devices, Modeling and Simulation, Smart Materials, Fabrication Technologies and Systems & Applications. The best posters will be rewarded and ISSS PhD student award for 2019 will be presented at this event.

Eligibility

JRF/ SRF / Full time research scholars / Postgraduate students of recognized institutions/universities anywhere in India are eligible to apply. National MEMS Design Centres and other institutes with research groups in the above areas are encouraged to send participants.

There is NO registration fee to attend this event. However, all candidates **must fill the request form** and upload a synopsis with details of their original research work (with graphs and figures) to demonstrate their research contributions. In addition, they may also include links to any previously published papers. Those attended 2018 edition of this event will not be eligible for travel support from the organizers.

Awards

In addition to the best poster award, the best work of a PhD student, evaluated based on synopsis, 3MT and poster will be given the 2019 ISSS PhD Student Award. Only those completing research in 2018-19 will be considered for this award.

How to Apply

There is NO registration fee to attend this event. However, prior registration is mandatory. Follow this link and fill the online **APPLICATION FORM**. Subject to availability, applicants will receive a provisional acceptance. In order to provide a fair opportunity the maximum number of interested participants, the registration **will be confirmed only for the first 50 outstation participants AFTER uploading the soft copies of travel documents (ticket) and a draft for poster** in the prescribed format within the deadline mentioned in the provisional acceptance mail.

Travel Support

Participants must make their own arrangements to travel to Bangalore to attend this event. **Eligible ISSS members and full time research students who have completed at least three years of post graduate research work will be eligible for limited travel support from the organizers.** *Up to 3 Tier AC train fare by the shortest route may be reimbursed to these outstation participants on production of actual travel bills, boarding pass etc. Incidental expenses of up to Rs 500 may be provided on production of bills. If requested, a shared accommodation in may be arranged by the organizers for up to three nights only at a Guest House close to the Indian Institute of Science.*
